The defendant has filed under seal and <u>ex parte</u> a motion (dkt. no. 184) for the appointment of David I. Bruck as second learned counsel under 18 U.S.C. §§ 3005 and 3599(a). The motion shall remain under seal and <u>ex parte</u>, as it reveals confidential defense information.

The CJA Guidelines on Appointment of Counsel in Capital Cases provide that "[u]nder 18 U.S.C. § 3599(a)(1), if necessary for adequate representation, more than two attorneys may be appointed to represent a defendant in a capital case." <u>Guide to Judiciary Policy</u>, Vol. 7, Ch. 6, § 620.10.10(b).

The defendant's prior requests for the appointment of David I. Bruck were denied without prejudice to renewal. In his present request, the defendant has made a satisfactory showing that the appointment of Mr. Bruck is "necessary for adequate representation."

Accordingly, the defendant's Motion (dkt. no. 184) to Appoint Counsel is GRANTED. It is SO ORDERED.
